



## TOOLS

Your supply of tools are not that hard to accumulate.

The small needle with eye, the needle with the round head, and the needle threader can all be found in your mother's sewing box, along with the scissors.

The tweezers and razorblades can be found in your dad's medicine cabinet. Almost all homes have a pair of pliers, bottle of glue, a magnifying glass, ruler or scale along with a 1" x 2" x 6" block of wood.

Any hardware store has small cans of paint and paint brushes. One can of paint will last you for about 25 boats, and you will only need three very small artist paint brushes.

The end nippers, drill gauge and pin vice can be purchased at any store or supply house for machine shops.

The scissors clamp and surgical clamp can be found around any hospital or doctor's office. When they start to get rusty they can't use them any more so they throw them away.

The rod is 3/16" in diameter x 14" long. Bend to shape.
